

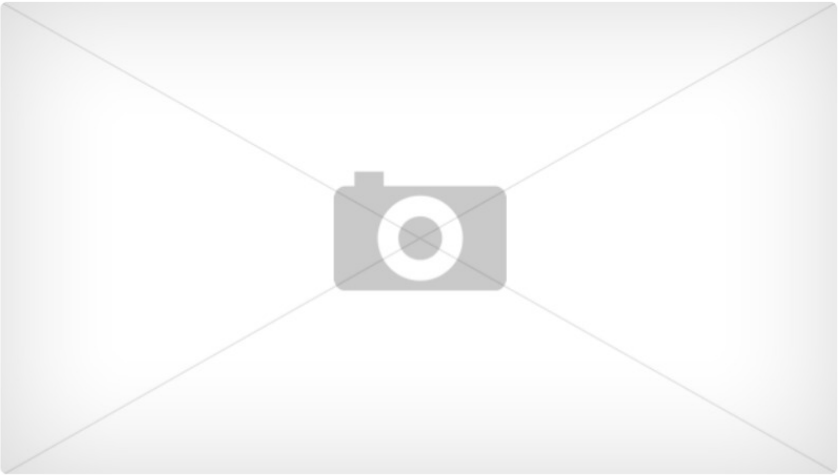

Chile's Guerrero Olivos strengthens mining practice with new partner

Chilean law firm Guerrero Olivos has strengthened its mining practice with the incorporation of María Paz Pulgar as a partner.

“María Paz has played a fundamental role in the Chilean mining industry, where women are increasingly taking a prominent position,” the law firm said.
